

COVID-19: DPPO Community Property

Yesterday, on March 30, 2020, the provincial government issued a new emergency order under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act to close all outdoor recreational amenities, such as sports fields and playgrounds, effective immediately. These actions were made based on the advice of the Province's Chief Medical Officer of Health. The new order closes all communal or shared, public or private, outdoor recreational amenities everywhere in Ontario, including but not limited to playgrounds, sports fields, and tennis courts.

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR DUCLOS POINT:

Per the Provincial order, the DPPO field/park, playgrounds, tennis court, and right-of-ways are closed and must not be used by you, your family members, or any guests at any time, for any purpose, until further notice.

While you may walk through the large DPPO-owned field, please do not congregate in the field and maintain a physical distance of at least 2 meters/6 feet apart from others.

The Board of Directors will continue to monitor developments at the federal, provincial, and municipal/local levels and we commit to providing you information that impacts Duclos Point and its residents in a timely manner.
