Hello DPPO Residents:

Hoping everyone enjoyed a healthy and safe winter. So nice to have the warmer temps, sunshine and longer days. Nice to see everything greening up and large flocks migrating birds stopping by.

Below are some of the things that have been done over the winter as well as information on some upcoming events.

1. Maintenance

Over the fall and winter many dead or dying trees were removed by the Town. These were stumped and have been replaced by 18 new trees around the large park. We are requesting the Town to also plant some additional trees at the north end of the large park – particularly a kind that will absorb more water.

As requested, the Town also filled in the dirt triangle on the road at the southwest end of the park. The asphalt is a temporary repair and we are requesting some type of nicer surface be installed.

2. Financial information

The financial statements for the 2022 year have been completed and are now being audited. These will be available prior to the Annual Meeting.

The Board has prepared a budget for the 2023 year and this is presently being finalized.

3. Annual General Meeting

This year our AGM will be held on **Saturday July 8** at 10:00 a.m. (rain date of Sunday July 9). We have confirmation that Mayor Quirk and our new Councillor Lee Dale will attend. If you have any specific issues you would like them to address, please submit these to any director prior to the meeting.
