

GOOD NEIGHBOURS GUIDE

Key Takeaways from the July 7, 2018 Meeting Between Duclos Point Property Owners and the Town of Georgina

The document is intended to provide information to address some concerns raised by the Duclos Point Road neighbourhood, most recently at the July 7, 2018 meeting with Town of Georgina representatives.

This guide is intended for property owners on Duclos Point Road as well as builders, contractors, landscaping professionals, and other service providers procured by property owners.

The content in this document is based on Town of Georgina by-laws; as by-laws are subject to change, please refer to the source documents for the by-laws (hyperlinked throughout) for up-to-date information.

PARKING: Town-owned property may be subject to Town of Georgina by-laws that regulate parking.

Parking is prohibited in the DPPO-owned park and 3 right-of-ways at all times.

FIREWORKS: Firework sales and setting-off is regulated by the Town of Georgina. Fireworks setting-off is prohibited (without a licence) except on the day preceding, the day of, and the day following Victoria Day and Canada Day. Any other setting-off requires a licence which can only be acquired by an in-person application.

NOISE: The Town of Georgina regulates noise in residential areas. There is a general prohibition provision in the by-law that states: "No person shall make, create, cause, or cause or permit to be made noise likely to disturb the inhabitants." Pursuant to the by-law:

- Noise created by "operation of any equipment in connection with construction" is deemed likely to disturb the inhabitants FROM 8:00 P.M. ONE DAY TO 7:00 A.M. THE NEXT DAY AND ALL DAY SUNDAYS AND STATUTORY HOLIDAYS. Note that "construction" is defined in the noise by-law.
- Noise created by "operation or use of any tool for domestic purposes other than snow removal" is deemed likely to disturb the inhabitants FROM 8:00 P.M. ONE DAY TO 7:00 A.M THE NEXT DAY.

OPEN-AIR BURNING: The Town of Georgina has rules around open-air burning of materials. Openair burns (recreational) that are no bigger than 2 feet x 2 feet do not require a permit. Anything that exceeds this requires a permit.
